

As a company certified by the FSC®, we can offer FSC® Pure, FSC® Mixed and FSC® Recycled paper and board (see Product Group Schedule), thus giving our clients the freedom to use an environmentally friendly substrate of their choice.

The person responsible for the co-ordination of FSC® at the company is the Quality Manager.

It is the policy of this company not to be directly or indirectly involved in the following activities:

- Illegal logging or the trade in illegal wood or forest products;
- Violation of traditional and human rights in forestry operations;
- Destruction of high conservation values in forestry operations;
- Significant conversion of forests to plantations or non-forest use;
- Introduction of genetically modified organisms in forestry operations;
- Violation of any of the ILO Core Conventions, as defined in the ILC Declaration on Fundamental Principal and Rights at Work, 1998.
